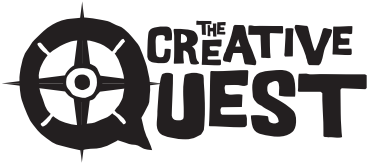


# The Creative Quest | TOUR HIGHLIGHTS



**The Creative Quest** is a self-guided, storewide scavenger hunt at **Michaels** that highlights concepts related to art while encouraging children to use critical thinking skills and teamwork. Each stop of the scavenger hunt allows children to explore one of the six elements of art. Lessons are applied at the end of the tour when the children get to create an art project to take home. This trip aligns with your art curriculum and local learning standards.

- Experience art, the artistic process and creative thinking
- Explore concepts of shape and size
- Practice problem solving and math principles such as weight
- Use color as a form of self expression
- Develop art literacy and vocabulary
- Understand space and negative space as it relates to art
- Express emotions and memory through art
- Identify the elements and various mediums of art
- Incorporate art into everyday life

**Upon arrival at the store, you will be provided with additional materials to help guide your group through their exploration of the elements. Content will include questions, clues and fun facts appropriate for grades K - 6.**

Area of the Store	Explored Elements
Bead Corner™	<b>FORM:</b> Anything that takes up space and has weight has form. <b>Activity:</b> Describe and create form.
Floral Section	<b>COLOR:</b> Part of what you see when light is reflected off an object is color. <b>Activity:</b> Experience how the senses relate to color.
Scrapbook Section	<b>SPACE:</b> The distance or area between, around or within objects is space. <b>Activity:</b> Explore scrapbooking.
Art Supply Section	<b>LINE:</b> A continuous mark made on a surface is a line. <b>Activity:</b> Investigate how to create line.
Kids Crafts Section	<b>SHAPE:</b> Two or three dimensional space enclosed by elements of art, such as lines, is a shape. <b>Activity:</b> Transform into shapes.
Yarn Section	<b>TEXTURE:</b> The surface quality or feel of an object is its texture. <b>Activity:</b> Find and describe different textures.
Art Project	<b>THE SIX ELEMENTS OF ART</b> <b>Activity:</b> The six elements of art are applied to the creative process through a hands-on art project.
